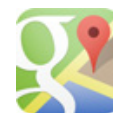

Documents to bring with you on arrival

- Your ID card, passport or residence permit
- Proof of address less than 3 months old and/or proof of accommodation
- Your valid 'Carte Vitale' national health insurance card
- Your complementary health insurance card (valid only in the event of hospitalisation) and complementary health insurance cover
- Your complementary universal health care coverage (CMU) or state medical aid (AME) certificate
- The occupational injury slip provided by the employer (where relevant)
- For European Union nationals, the original E111 document.

Without cover, you will be liable to pay all costs.

Assistance

Argenteuil hospital has a **social work department** for patients open from Monday to Friday from 9 am to 12.15 pm and from 1.15 pm to 4 pm.

You can request the assistance of a social worker by asking the nursing staff of the ward on which you are being cared for. You can also contact the social worker yourself by telephoning 01 34 23 26 46.

It is possible to request the assistance of certain members of the hospital staff, who speak different languages, to enable us to meet your needs and give you information relating to your care and to enable you to make yourself understood. Ask the nursing staff.

- Sundays from 10 am to 2 pm and from 4 pm to midnight

Where? At the entrance to the hospital

Statutory fees as fixed by Social Security with no excess charges; usual surcharge for consultations in the evening, Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.
